I am delighted to be chairing the first global 'Crisis Management in Tall Buildings' conference here in London. Of course there have been previous conferences held - whether closed to law enforcement, closed to corporate groups or held as part of a wider conference or exhibition

- but this is the first, as far as we can ascertain, that is dedicated to the discrete requirements of tall buildings.

I was a career detective in the Metropolitan Police Service, rising to the rank of Commander. I was also fortunate to be trained by both the UK authorities at Hendon and US authorities at Quantico to be a hostage negotiator and crisis manager. Whenever deployed here or abroad as a negotiator, or attending COBRA, rank didn't matter. We were a team.

I thought that I had done my bit having served 30 years in the Met and then a further 10 years as a deputy director in the Serious Organised Crime Agency and the National Crime Agency - early retirement beckoned. However, a year after that early release, my former Commissioner, Lord Stevens of Kirkwhelpington, called to say he had "a job for me". Within 10 days of a first interview I was appointed Head of Security at The Shard.

Each day of the three years at The Shard was different: it was like being a Borough Commander in the police. It was a 24/7, 365 (366 this year!) job; and you didn't know what the next phone call or the next 'excuse me...' would bring. My extensive training in the police and SOCA/NCA held me in good stead, but there was a whole new language and culture to learn! Any small issue could easily expand to be a crisis and we built on and devised processes to respond as a team: any issue could prove to be too big for one or two people. There were always others that could be affected, a knock-on impact, or need for a communiqué.

This conference brings together experts and professionals to consider and discuss the challenges presented in and by tall buildings - some unique and restricted to high-rise buildings alone. We want to ensure that you are able to identify potential crises and prevent or better deal with them. Please take time in the margins to discuss issues with colleagues, many from across the UK and further afield. Introduce yourself to others – they could be owners, facilities managers, service providers, occupiers or others from the emergency services.

#### ANDY BAKER

Andy Baker was a career detective who served 30 years in the Metropolitan Police Service attaining the rank of Commander. He then served 10 years as a deputy director in the UK's Serious Organised Crime Agency / National Crime Agency. He has undertaken the role of 'Gold' over 750 times in

the MPS and around 100 times in his various senior roles in SOCA/NCA.

On retirement, he was head hunted into the Corporate World as Head of Security and was employed by Real Estate Management Limited – a company managing sites across London including The Shard.

During his three year stint at REM he realigned their Emergency Response Plan into a more flexible Incident Response Plan; provided training to Executives and senior managers in the Company. He continues to advise REM and other companies on their crisis management processes and response to incidents.



## **Speaker Profiles**



#### STUART OSBORNE QPM

Stuart Osborne has an extensive career in the public and private sector. He is a former Chief Police Officer retiring from The Metropolitan Police as a Deputy Assistant Commissioner where he held several national and international policing portfolios. More recently he has worked as a senior

executive in a FTSE top 50 defence organisation with global responsibility for risk and security; and leading FTSE facilities management and consulting organisation as group head of risk and Managing Director for Risk and Resilience Consulting.

As Senior National Coordinator for UK Counter Terrorism, Stuart was the lead for all Counter Terrorism Investigations and Intelligence within the UK and for British interests overseas. He specialises in holistic security, resilience and risk management, security and business development, specialist protection and investigations and strategic leadership. Stuart has worked extensively in partnership with international business, government, military, worldwide law enforcement agencies and British security and intelligence services. He has held various International portfolios covering counter terrorism, risk assessment to prevent financial loss and personal injury, espionage investigations, insider threat prevention and anti-corruption practices.

As Director of Global Security for BA Systems between 2013-17, Stuart designed and led a Group-wide Risk, Security and Operations Business Transformation Programme that reduced organisational cost; enhanced client and employee confidence; and delivered increased shareholder value.

Whilst Head of Group Risk for Mitie, Stuart created and implemented new risk governance structures for all group businesses and 56,000 staff and contractors. This included the development of unique threat assessment and risk management tools and processes. These resulted in the design of risk and vulnerability resolutions that have reduced costs and improved business confidence. Additionally, he created and managed a Risk and Resilience consultancy business with an annual revenue of £2 Million.

Stuart was made a life member of the UK Association of Chief Police Officers in 2013 and he is a full member of the FBI chaired International Association Chief Police committee on terrorism. He is an Advisor to the UK government protection of the national infrastructure chaired Register of Security Experts and Specialists. Stuart was awarded the Queens Police Medal for leading organizational change and Counter Terrorism in 2011.

He has a Master of Science Degree in Security Management, Post graduate Diploma in Advanced Criminology and has written extensively on the motivation and methodology of those who commit 'Tiger Kidnaps'.
